INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION

CONSTRUCTION OF ACCRA-KUMASI EXPRESSWAY

Procurement Reference No.: AKEL/PQ/2026/01

The Government of the Republic of Ghana has established Accra–Kumasi Expressway Limited (AKEL) as a special purpose vehicle (subsidiary) under the Ghana Infrastructure Investment Fund (GIIF) to undertake the development, financing, construction, operation and maintenance of the Accra–Kumasi Expressway under the applicable concession arrangements with the Government of Ghana.

The Accra–Kumasi Expressway is a major national infrastructure project intended to improve connectivity between Accra and Kumasi, enhance the movement of people and goods, reduce travel time and logistics costs, improve road safety and support economic growth and regional development.

AKEL intends to prequalify Contractors for the Construction of the Accra – Kumasi Expressway. The Works comprise the construction of a new 199.383 km controlled-access expressway between Accra and Kumasi, consisting:

- i. 175.85 km three-lane dual carriageway mainline and 23.533 km of connector roads at the Accra and Kumasi ends,
- ii. eight (8) grade-separated interchanges at Ablekuma New Town, Adeiso, Asamankese, Akim Oda, Ofoase, Asante Ofoase, Lake Bosomtwe and Sewua Junction Lake Road, and eleven (11) vehicular overpasses,
- iii. sixty-two (62) bridges including crossings of the Pra, Anum, Birim, Nsaki, and Densu rivers,
- iv. 209 reinforced Box Culverts on the mainline, together with underpasses, pedestrian crossings and grade separations, four service areas and eight toll stations, drainage works, road furniture, and the civil works for tolling and intelligent transport system infrastructure. It is expected that the Invitations to Tender will be made on 23rd October 2026.

The prequalification will be conducted through prequalification procedures specified in the Public Procurement Act, 2003 and as amendment Act, 2016 (Act 914) and amendment Act, 2025 (Act 1139) of the Republic of Ghana and is open to all Applicants from eligible source countries, as determined by the Public Procurement Authority of the Republic of Ghana.
